
AGREEMENT

By placing a bid, you agree to the Terms and Conditions of the Auction as set out in the latest revision of this document. Changes and revisions to this Terms and Conditions document will also be posted on The Jig Store website. It is the Bidder's responsibility to check the website for the latest Revision.

AUCTION BASICS

1. **The Documents.** The relevant bidding documents can be found on The Jig Store website at: <www.jigstore.com/auctionfolder.htm>.
 2. **Closing Date and Time.** There is no preset Closing Date and Time for an Item in the Auction. The auction will close without notice if there have been no bids for a few days. The bidding status of the Item is displayed on the web page as either OPEN (green), or INACTIVE (orange) or CLOSED (red).
 3. **Bidding Amount.** Bidding is in \$25 increments unless otherwise stated on the Item information sheet.
 4. **Reserve.** See the Item information sheet for the minimum bid amount.
 5. **Additional Fees.** Auction companies apply an additional fee to the Successful Bidder called a "Buyer's Premium". In this Auction there is no buyer's premium and there are no additional fees. You pay only the amount you bid, plus the shipping, handling and insurance cost specific to each Item.

HOW TO PLACE YOUR FIRST BID

6. **Bidding Is via Email Only.** 1) Address your email to kevan@akeda.com. If your email bounces, send your email to mlear@akeda.com instead. 2) **THIS IS VERY IMPORTANT. Place ONLY the following information in the subject line, in this order, with a dash between each:** #ITEM - YOUR INITIALS - YOUR STATE OR PROVINCE - AMOUNT OF BID (Example: #200-PD-MO-\$225). 3) Leave the body of your email blank. A bid that is not presented in this format may not be accepted.
 7. **Ordering of Bids.** Bids are ordered first by the amount bid, and second by the date and time of the bid, as determined by the date and time stamp on the email at the receiving end.
 8. **Website Table of Bids.** You will not receive an email acknowledging your bid. Only the highest bid will be posted. Akeda / The Jig Store will not begin posting bids on the website Table of Bids table on the Auction web page until a few days soon after the launch of the Auction. Thereafter the table will be updated once a day at approximately 11:00pm EST (10:00pm CST, 9:00pm MST, 8:00pm PST) or more frequently if necessary.
 9. **If You Do Not See Your Bid.** If you do not see your bid on the web page table it may be because: a) you need to refresh (or reload) the window in your browser; b) your bid was superseded by a higher bid or bids; c) your bid was superseded by an earlier bid or bids of the same amount; or d) there has been a delay updating the web page, which can happen for a variety of human and technical reasons.
 10. **Successful Bid.** The highest bid for the Item will be the successful bid.

HOW TO PLACE SUBSEQUENT BIDS

11. **Increasing Your Bid.** There is no limit to the number of bids you can place on the Item. Always use the same email format specified in paragraph 6 above every time you bid up. Only your highest bid on the Item will be placed. Any and all previous lower bid(s) will be deleted.
 12. **Cancelling A Bid.** Bidders may cancel their bid by email, without reason or explanation, at any time, up to the close of the Auction Item. **IMPORTANT.** To cancel, use the following format in the subject line of your email: ITEM# - YOUR INITIALS - YOUR STATE OR PROVINCE - CANCEL (for example, #300-DF-TX-CANCEL). Leave the body of your email blank. You will receive an email acknowledging your cancellation.
 13. **Decreasing A Bid.** Bidders may decrease the amount of their bid up to the Closing Date and Time. First cancel the previous bid (see format in paragraph 12 above) and then submit a fresh bid with the new amount (see format in paragraph 6 above).
 14. **Repeating The Same Bid Amount.** Repeat bids of the same amount will not be accepted. The first (earlier) bid will apply.
 15. **Web Page.** The Item in the table of Bids will be deleted 30 days following the closing of the Auction.
 16. **No Bids.** If no bids are received on a particular Item, the Item will be withdrawn from the Auction after a reasonable period of time.

PAYMENT AND SHIPPING

17. **Payment.** Instructions for payment will be sent to the Successful Bidder by email, using the email address provided.
18. **PayPal.** Akeda / The Jig Store will request payment from PayPal using the email address provided by the Successful Bidder. If the Successful Bidder uses a different email address for their PayPal account, they must notify mlear@akeda.com to enable PayPal to issue a request for payment. If the Successful Bidder does not have an account with PayPal, PayPal will request payment using the email address originally supplied. The Successful Bidder must pay PayPal the amount of the bid in full, plus the shipping, handling and insurance specific to the Item within 10 days of request for payment.
19. **Shipping.** The product will be shipped within 10 days of receipt of payment. You will receive confirmation of shipping by email together with the tracking number. **AKEDA / The Jig Store will place insurance on the shipment on your behalf, as the beneficiary.**
20. **Damage Or Loss.** AKEDA /The Jig Store will not accept any responsibility for shipping damage or loss. If the product is to be shipped to a high theft area you are strongly advised to provide a shipping address where the product can be received **in person**, not left, for example, on a porch or doorstep. Any loss or damage claim must be taken up with the shipping company.
21. **Replacement Products.** AKEDA has no products to provide as replacements in the event of loss or damage.

OTHER TERMS AND CONDITIONS

22. **Personal Information of Successful Bidders.** The personal information of Successful Bidders will be held for 30 days following the Closing Date and Time of the Auction. In the event anyone wishes to question in writing the veracity of the Auction and requests a list of Successful Bidders, the Successful Bidders agree that The Jig Store may provide their names and email addresses only to the enquirer.
 23. **Personal Information of Unsuccessful Bidders.** All the personal information of the Unsuccessful Bidders will be destroyed within 30 days of the Closing Date and Time of the Auction.
 24. **Privacy.** Your personal information will not be given away or sold and it will not be published on line.
 25. **Geographical Limitation.** The Auction is limited to the North American continent.
 26. **ALL SALES ARE FINAL.** Returns and exchanges are not possible, with one exception – if you believe the Item has been misrepresented, Akeda / The Jig Store will, upon receipt of the Item, reimburse the Bidder the full amount paid plus return shipping.
 27. **Warranty.** None of the products carries a warranty.
 28. **Currency.** American residents are bidding in US dollars and Canadian residents are bidding in Canadian dollars. For the purpose of this Auction, for the purpose of determining the Successful Bidder and for the purpose of payment, the two currencies will be regarded as though they are at par, meaning one American dollar is equal to one Canadian dollar.
 29. **Product Condition.** Although some products are new in the box, the Bidder accepts the possibility that their Item may have minor cosmetic flaws that do not affect the performance of the product.
 30. **Cancellation.** Akeda / The Jig Store holds the sole right to remove any or all Items from the Auction, at any time, without explanation.
 31. **Questions.** Use a separate email if you have a question. If you receive no reply, it means either that the answer to your question already exists in one of the Auction documents, and/or it has been addressed by a new revision of the documents. Check the website for the latest Revision.
 32. **In The Event Of A Dispute.** If a dispute cannot be settled between a Bidder and Akeda / The Jig Store, the decision of an independent Canadian arbitrator will be binding.
